Target group / admission requirements

You would like to work in the tourism industry or connect with the global job market, or are already in work and want to expand your skills.

You are at least 16 years old, have a high school certificate, or equivalent and have completed 12 years of schooling. In addition you have completed vocational training of at least 2 years duration or you have at least 3 years of work experience. Lessons will be taught in English, so it is necessary that you should have knowledge in the English language at secondary level.

The "Partner Schools Abroad" may however adjust the admission criteria, keeping in view their national education systems.

Study programs

This program offers a rigorous course of instruction that will prepare you to investigate and understand the complexities of languages. The program has been carefully designed to offer you a rich and complete linguistic education, while offering flexibility and opportunities to follow your personal interests.

Being multilingual is not a luxury any longer; it has rather become a necessity, our language learning programs are carefully planned to meet the learning needs of each client. People have a variety of reasons for wanting to learn a language: communicating effectively with colleagues or clients, writing letters, obtaining information, listening to others or conversing socially.

Certifications

Certificate will be awarded upon completion of each level; in addition to:

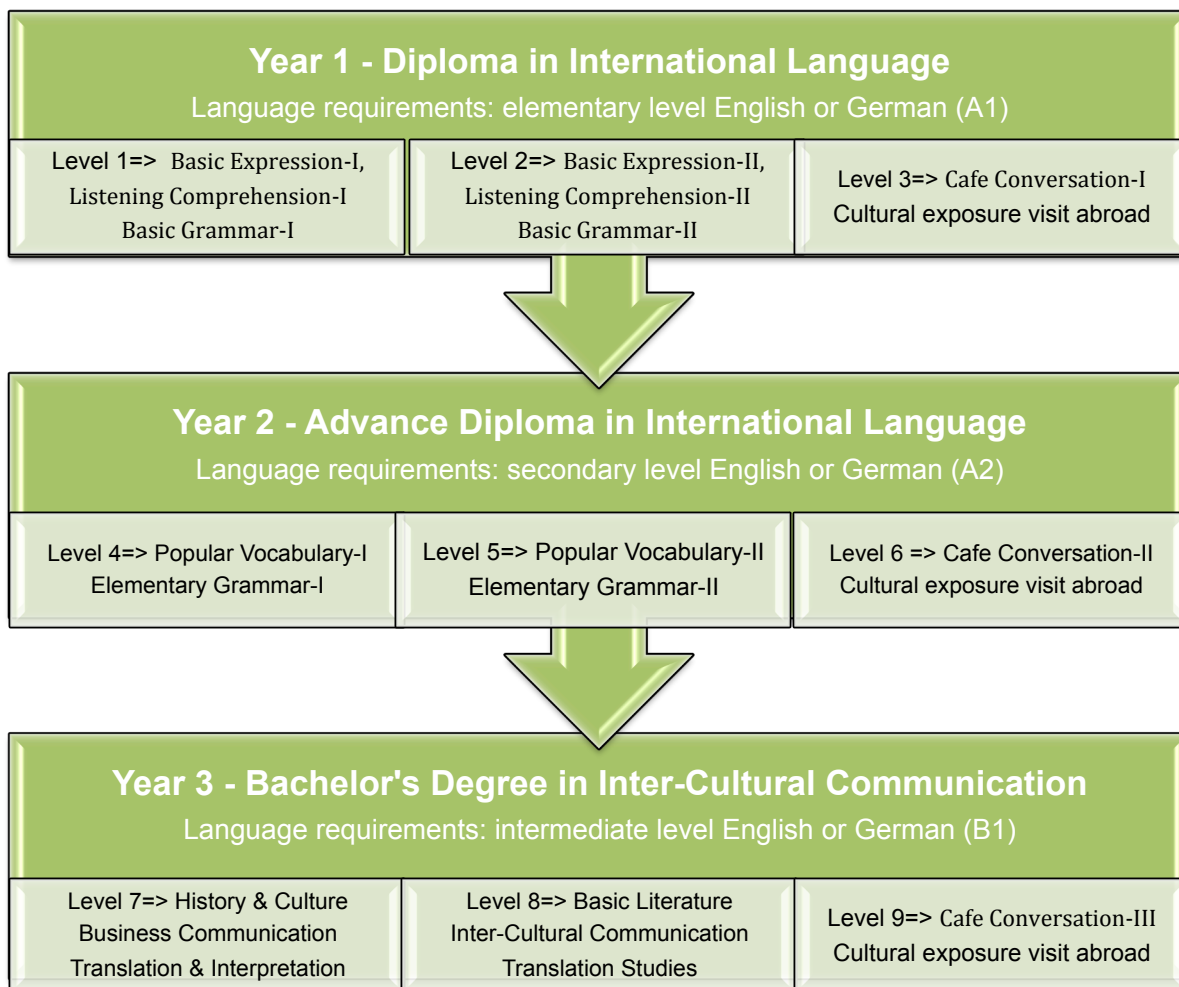
Levels 1-3	Diploma upon completion of Level-3.
Levels 4-6	Advance Diploma will be awarded upon completion of level-6.
Levels 7-9	Bachelor Degree will be awarded to the successful students.

An **Advanced Language Diploma** holder can pursue his/her **Bachelor's** in **Inter-Cultural Communication** or in **Translation Studies** in next one year, by adding a Diploma in either a secondary language or a Diploma in Translation Studies. Additional modules / courses can be added to comply with the mandatory educational requirement of any country, where our partner school offers these courses/degree programs.

There will be an international exposure visit towards the end of each academic year.

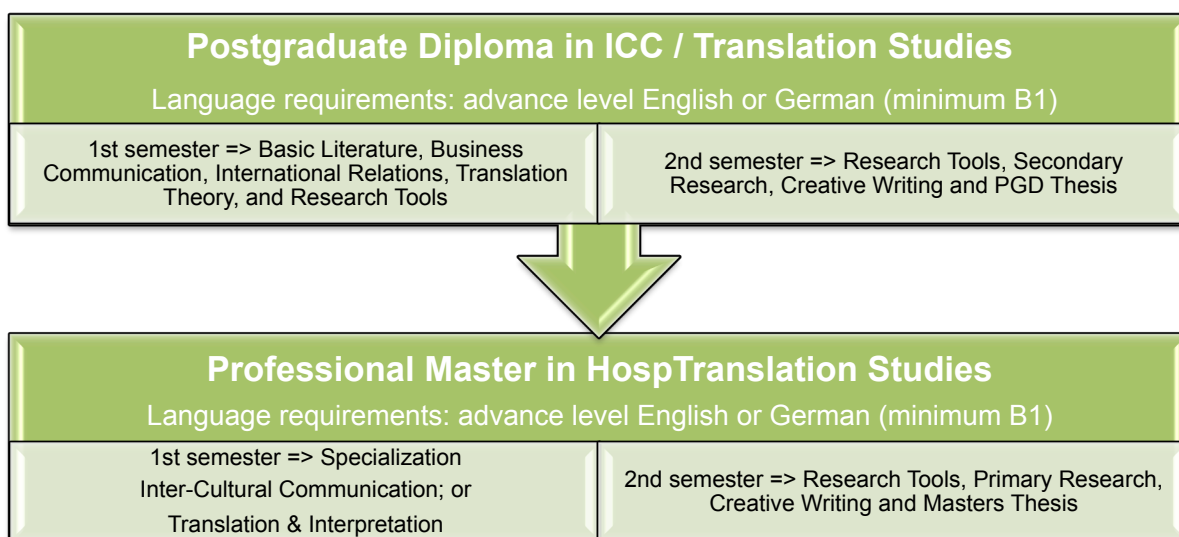
Diploma training courses with individual and further studying possibilities (modules can be taken separately)
